GE Aviation wins NASA contract

Evendale-based GE Aviation is one of five companies that have been awarded propulsion research contracts by NASA, the aerospace agency said.

Each five-year contract has a maximum limit of \$125 million, with no set quantities or delivery times at this point, NASA said in a news release.

The contracts will support aerospace propulsion research at the Glenn Research Center in Cleveland, centering on "development and demonstration of advanced turbine engine technologies to enhance aviation safety and reduce aircraft emissions, noise and fuel burning," NASA said in the release.

The other companies receiving contracts include: Honeywell of Phoenix; United Technologies Corp., Pratt & Whitney Military Engines of East Hartford, Conn.; Rolls-Royce North American Technologies Inc. Liberty Works of Indianapolis; and Williams International of Walled Lake, Mich.
