# L-3 Communications unit wins \$24M military contract

L-3 Fuzing and Ordnance Systems in Anderson Township won a \$24 million contract from a U.S. Army arsenal, according to an online announcement from the U.S. Department of Defense.

The company will complete the work by mid-September 2013 for Picatinny Arsenal in Lake Denmark, N.J., according to the announcement. It was the only bidder for the contract.

L-3 Fuzing supplies military ordnance and fuses. It is a unit of **L-3 Communications** (NYSE: LLL), a New York-based company with more than 100 business units worldwide. L-3 has two other local operations: Nova Engineering in West Chester and Cincinnati Electronics in Mason.
