## ODOT to build 'superstreet' In Butler Co.

Work to build several "superstreet" intersections along the State Route 4 bypass corridor will begin this week in Butler County, according to a report on WLWT.com.

A novelty for Ohio, the Ohio Department of Transportation's superstreet intersection is designed to improve safety and travel time, reducing delays by up to 90 percent. It also contains fewer conflict points than a conventional intersection, which can reduce the number of crashes, according to the report.

New intersections will be built along the bypass at Tylersville Road, Hamilton Mason Road and Symmes Road through the summer, according to the report.
