Health Alliance names West Chester chief

The **Health Alliance** appointed Dr. Kevin Joseph as interim president of **West Chester Medical Center**.

Joseph will replace Carol King as the hospital system moves toward physician leadership. Health Alliance interim CEO Rick Hinds made the announcement in a memo to employees today.

The Health Alliance also recently ousted Lee Ann Liska from the top spot at **University Hospital**. She has snapped up another job, as chief operating officer at **Mercy Health Partners**.

The Health Alliance has not officially named her replacement.

Joseph most recently served as the director of emergency services at West Chester and “has played an integral role in the development of the hospital since the earliest stages of its planning and opening last year,” Hinds wrote.

Joseph will have the help of George Caralis, who is being appointed as interim chief operating officer at the West Chester hospital.

Additionally, the Health Alliance appointed Rosemary Keiser as vice president of perioperative services, a systemwide position.
