

Homearama moves to West Chester Twp.

WEST CHESTER TWP. — The homes will be a little bit lower in price for the 49th Homearama event, according to a press release from the Home Builders Association of Greater Cincinnati.

Slated for June 11-26, 2011, the popular regional home show, which was canceled for 2010, has moved from Mason to the Glenview Estates section of the Foxborough subdivision in West Chester Twp. Homes to show will range from \$525,000 to \$850,000, according to the HBA.

Foxborough is a community of Cobblestone Development and The Drees Co.

“The community sits on one of the highest points in the township providing sweeping vistas of the countryside and the alluring, evening lights of downtown West Chester,” said Dan Dressman, executive director of the HBAGC.

“We encourage people interested in purchasing a show home to contact one of the HBA’s show builders by calling (513) 851-6300 or by visiting www.cincybuilders.com in the next few weeks,” Dressman said.

Luxury homes in Warren County have been spotlighted in seven of the past eight years. In 2009, the show was moved from Long Cove — where home prices range in millions — to the Carmelle subdivision in Mason, with houses in the \$550,000 to \$950,000 range.
