


What's New in West Chester!



FORTUNE RANKS WEST CHESTER 13th BEST PLACE TO LIVE IN U.S.

In its analysis of nearly 1,900 cities across the country by <u>Fortune Magazine</u>, <u>West Chester Township</u> ranked 13th as the Best Place to Live for Families in the U.S. The winners of the best places to live were communities scoring high on assets including healthcare, education and resources. Fortune factors in data like affordability, walkability, and a community's well-being or connectedness where people can easily link to resources in neighboring towns and surrounding areas. With West Chester being centrally located off Interstate 75 between Cincinnati and Dayton, it's easy to see why this was a prominent factor in West Chester's selection.

Having ample healthcare resources was a major influence in West Chester making the list. West Chester's solid system of healthcare providers within the township, and in neighboring communities, makes it easy for residents to find a variety of reliable healthcare providers close to home. In addition, <u>UC Health's West Chester Hospital</u> provides the community with a comprehensive 216-bed, full-service premier hospital. The hospital offers emergency medicine as a Level III trauma center, has 12 state-of-the-art operating rooms and is one of the township's major employers. The surrounding University Pointe medical campus also houses an abundance of ancillary medical service providers to support the community's healthcare needs.

Another important factor when looking for a community to call home is finding a neighborhood that has quality school districts with great academic reputations located in safe environments. West Chester is fortunate to be in the <u>Lakota</u> <u>Local School District</u> which is Ohio's 8th largest district and consistently receives excellent ratings across the board. West Chester's residents demonstrate their obvious value of education with more than 50% of West Chester's adult population having a bachelor's degree or higher.

When making its decision, Fortune also looked at each community's recreational activities, amenities, services and features that help support the goals of residents to remain active.

West Chester maintains more than <u>400 acres</u> of recreational space with programming for all ages including concerts, festivals and classes for young people. More than <u>1,500 acres</u> of shopping, dining and entertainment amenities have been developed with more than 200 diverse restaurants and <u>2,200 hotel rooms</u> available to service businesses, tourists and residential consumers.

WEST CHESTER MAKES A SPLASH

West Chester Township announced construction of a \$1.54 million <u>splash playground at Beckett Park</u>, 8545 Beckett Road, with construction beginning this summer and a Spring 2024 opening expected.

The splash playground received approval from the <u>West Chester Board of Trustees</u> at its regular meeting Tuesday, <u>May 9</u>, <u>2023</u>.

"A water playground was first envisioned for <u>Beckett Park</u> more than two decades ago and water play areas continue to be a request we hear from residents," said Township Administrator Larry D. Burks. "It's exciting in the Township's <u>bicentennial year</u> to break ground on this project and make it a reality."

The splash playground will feature varied opportunities for water play accessible to children of all abilities. Shade structures and seating will also be incorporated into the design.

Beckett Park is already home to a boundless playground, the West Chester Baseball Complex and the Muhlhauser Barn.

"The new splash playground will be a great complement to the natural trails, walkways and ponds on the west side of Beckett Park," said <u>Community Services</u> Director Arun Hindupur.

The project will be funded with State Route 747 TIF resources generated by corporate development. This is a <u>TIF</u>-eligible expense as are other community amenities, infrastructure improvements and public safety equipment.

West Chester will announce a community ground-breaking event for later this summer.

The splash playground will be constructed in an area now allocated as a man-made water feature near a picnic shelter. The water feature was built with intentions of freezing naturally in the winter months for ice skating. These intentions, however, did not pan out due to maintenance issues over the years and insufficient freezing temperatures preventing the feature's use as an ice rink. The small pool has since become a maintenance issue due to the increasing geese population.

We gutted this little house, added more plumbing and electric to turn it into our dream salon and opened our doors in May of 2021. We are now a thriving business with 5 successful independent women working under our roof and could not be more excited! We look forward to all of the new business and amazing people in the city of West Chester who will hear about us now from having this store front sign that they can visibly see from the road while passing by our salon! The program is offered at NO COST to selected business owners who receive a full scholarship funded by the Goldman Sachs Foundation.
