DEVELOPING FUTURE WORKFORCE & UNLOCKING NEW OPPORTUNITIES

Butler Tech's plan to move forward with construction of a bio-sciences academy in West Chester's Midtown unlocks countless opportunities. High school students may train for jobs in the health/medical field. Hospitals and bio-science companies can coordinate training programs for their specific workforce. And a corridor, previously unrealized from an economic development standpoint, can reach its full potential benefitting the community overall.



Butler Tech, one of Ohio's largest career-technical schools, released drawings and announced a tentative groundbreaking for early 2014 on the first phase of a 150,000 square-foot campus just off the Cincinnati-Dayton Road interchange on I-75.

Superintendent of Butler Tech, Bill Miller said they are working with developers on a campus-like setting and are looking to a community college or university as a partner in the project. The goal, he said, would be to create an educational exit off I-75.

"Butler Tech's bio-sciences academy will be an institutional anchor for West Chester's Midtown at Cincinnati-Dayton Road," said Township Administrator Judi Boyko. "Butler Tech will stimulate future economic development in what has, to date, been an economically under-utilized area of the Township."

The site for Butler Tech, with additional available property nearby, has tremendous visibility and is easily accessible. More than 125,000 vehicles travel daily on I-75 through West Chester and pass the Cincinnati-Dayton Road interchange. Nearly 46,000 vehicles exit I-75 on Cincinnati-Dayton Road every day.

The life sciences/bio-medical industry is rapidly emerging and encompasses pharmaceutical and medicine manufacturing, medical device manufacturing, testing laboratories, medical labs and more. These companies tend to cluster together to symbiotically benefit from a shared workforce, advances in technology and new scientific discoveries.

West Chester is home to the largest concentration of life science companies in a single geographic area outside the Interstate 275 loop. Companies like Bristol-Meyers Squibb, AtriCure, Cardinal Health and others, along with West Chester Hospital, UC Physicians and Tri-Health have located in West Chester.

"Butler Tech's bio-sciences curriculum and technology will redefine the future of workforce development in medical-related fields for our region and will support the growing targeted industry of life sciences in our community," Mrs. Boyko said.

Property is still available for development in West Chester's Midtown at I-75 and Cincinnati-Dayton Road near this new campus development.
