### WEST CHESTER APPOINTS NEW TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATOR

The West Chester Board of Trustees approved a contract at its Dec. 5 meeting to hire Larry D. Burks as West Chester Township's next Administrator. Mr. Burks signed a three-year renewable contract with a starting salary of \$135,000 on Thursday, Dec. 7.

Mr. Burks, formerly an assistant city manager of Bellevue, Nebraska, will take office in early 2018. He replaces former West Chester Administrator Judi Boyko who resigned effective Aug. 1, 2017 after a 13year career as West Chester's Administrator.

Mrs. Boyko is now Hamilton County's Assistant County Administrator.

West Chester Trustees, including newly elected Trustee Ann Becker, interviewed candidates for the position in early November and identified Mr. Burks as a strong candidate who will help lead West Chester into the future.

Bellevue, Nebraska is just outside of Omaha with a population of 51,000. Mr. Burks' focus in his current position is economic development, organizational management and strategic planning, but his skills extend to policy development, implementation and evaluation; public finance; sustainable development; performance management and benchmarking among others.

Mr. Burks has a master's degree in Public Administration from the University of Nebraska and is a credentialed manager through International City/County Managers Association. He has been employed by the City of Bellevue since 2012, having previously served as City Administrator, Zoning Administrator and Economic Development Coordinator for the City of Onawa, Iowa.

West Chester is a proven destination for corporate investment. Development Saturday, Nov. 25, 2017, marked the 20th anniversary of the opening of the Union Centre Boulevard interchange.

Groundbreaking on the I-75 project was in October 1996 and opening ceremonies were celebrated on Nov. 25, 1997.



When it opened to traffic that December, the interchange was the first new project of its kind built in Southwest Ohio in more than two decades. Visionary developers worked closely with elected officials at the Township, County and State level to make the \$29 million project a reality. Today, the Union Centre Boulevard Interchange serves as a catalyst for growth along the I-75 corridor.

Over the last 20 years, the Township has realized more than \$3.54 billion in new investment, more than 34 million square feet in new construction, and nearly 40,000 new jobs in the Union Centre Boulevard area alone. This corporate investment in the Township has supported public safety services, community amenities and infrastructure improvements.

"The Union Centre Boulevard interchange has defined West Chester's economic development position for the past 20 years and will continue to play a critical role in West Chester's future sustainability and marketability," said Aaron Wiegand, West Chester's Community Development Director. "There have been important advancements in medical and retail development at all of West Chester's interchanges, but none has been as diverse as and more impactful to our local economy than the growth at Union Centre."

West Chester's prime location in the Cincinnati-Dayton Metroplex and its ease of access with three primary interstate exits along I-75 continues to make the community an ideal choice for corporate development.

An average of 50,000 vehicles per day use the Union Centre Boulevard interchange and West Chester continually looks toward future demands of the infrastructure. The Board of Trustees has partnered with the Butler County Engineer's Office to consider next steps for ensuring Union Centre Boulevard remains a valuable, high functioning asset to the community.

"The typical design life of any road project when we look out over the years is 20 years, and we're starting to see the pressures on this interchange from the standpoint of capacity," Butler County Engineer Greg Wilkens told Trustees in March 2017.

Therefore, as the Union Centre Boulevard interchange marks its 20th birthday, plans are under way for a facelift and refresh of the existing infrastructure.

The Butler County Engineer's Office, with input from the Ohio Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, recommend a diverging diamond traffic pattern with pedestrian walkway. opportunities exist throughout West Chester with sites of one to 100 acres available. Office, manufacturing, research and development properties with accessible infrastructure, frontage on I-75 or within two miles of an interstate interchange are available.

West Chester's economic development professionals are prepared to find an available property to suit the needs of those seeking to relocate and/or grow in West Chester's no earnings tax, pro-business environment.

"We'd like to begin construction, optimistically, in 2019," Wilkens said, ideally after the BCEO's Cincinnati Dayton Road widening project is complete.

Estimated cost of the interchange improvement project is \$13 million which will be funded through TIF (revenue collected specifically from the businesses in the immediate area of the interchange).
