

What's New in West Chester!



WEST CHESTER BUSINESS COMMUNITY THRIVES

In 2020, SitesUSA estimated West Chester Township has 3,610 businesses employing nearly 51,600 people—68 percent of those employed are in the management, business, finance, sales, office and professional services industries.

The diverse, successful local economy of West Chester grew from careful planning and a business-friendly attitude coupled with ideal location and access. Symbiotic relationships have supported business investment without compromising exceptional residential opportunities making West Chester a place "where families grow and businesses prosper."

West Chester has the amenities to support businesses with nearly 200 restaurants to satisfy all appetites and more than 1,600 hotel rooms available for personal and business travelers—nearly 600 more hotel rooms are under construction. West Chester will have a total of 1.36 million square feet of hotel space to offer business travelers by 2021.

Many of West Chester's businesses form strategic partnerships or alliances, supporting one another in a variety of ways. A recent example is found with AeroFlexx and Fameccanica.

AeroFlexx, a company revolutionizing the packaging industry, will soon open a 27,043 square-foot facility at 8511 Trade Center Drive in the West Chester Trade Center off Union Centre Boulevard.

AeroFlexx offers the only flexible package with an air chamber that provides rigid qualities to a flexible package. The technology originally came from Cincinnati-based Procter & Gamble. Today, AeroFlexx has the exclusive rights to commercialize the technology across all categories and geographies to all partners, including P&G direct competitors. AeroFlexx proprietary package contains at least 50 percent less plastic, allows for greater flexibility in size and shape, provides efficiency in manufacturing, has no label limitations thanks to seamless edge-to-edge artwork, and meets e-commerce and sustainability requirements.

In late 2019, AeroFlexx and Fameccanica, a long-time West Chester international manufacturer of automation and robotic applications, formed a partnership. Fameccanica was selected after a global evaluation of world-class machine manufacturers to design, fabricate and scale the converting and liquid filling equipment for AeroFlexx. This partnership will accelerate the development and manufacture of the packaging solution. Fameccanica recently expanded and relocated its West Chester operations to an 84,843 square-foot facility in the West Chester Trade Center development.

Mutually beneficial partnerships, such as this, within the West Chester business community demonstrate the value of supporting diversity in economic development. Rather than reliance on one

industry, West Chester thrives because of the varied and symbiotic industries finding success here.

West Chester businesses also partner with local educational resources for training, seminars and conferences. Miami University Voice of America Learning Center and Butler Tech Bioscience Campus both partnered with UC Health West Chester Hospital prior to the pandemic to provide classes, training and facility space as needed. Butler Tech students trained at the hospital in their respective fields and Indiana Wesleyan offers professional educational courses, customizing training to business needs.

Schumacher Dugan Construction, a long-time West Chester business in the development industry, partners with other local businesses who plan to grow in the Township. Schumacher Dugan is currently building KEMBA Credit Union's new nine-story, 90,000 square-foot Class A corporate headquarters off Union Centre Boulevard.

There are numerous ancillary service providers—from information technology service providers like E-Technologies, to body shops like Lakota Body Shop, and fire suppression businesses like Johnson Controls—that all provide services to other businesses throughout the Township.

Many West Chester businesses benefit from the strengths each organization brings to the table. West Chester's business community will continue to grow and be successful as they form strategic partnerships and collaborate to support one another whenever possible.

"As the second largest center of commerce in the Tri-State area, trailing only Cincinnati-proper, West Chester offers an environment for business-to-business relationships to thrive. Working in concert with the West Chester-Liberty Chamber Alliance, REDI Cincinnati and other business partners, West Chester Township strives to create these connections where possible," said Aaron Wiegand, Community Development Director at West Chester Township.



WEST CHESTER RETAIL CENTER GETS MAJOR FACELIFT

One of West Chester's oldest and most visible shopping centers has a new look and new residents. Located at the intersection of Cox and Tylersville Roads for more than 30 years, Kingsgate Plaza is now Tylersville Pointe.

Midland Atlantic, developers of the Voice of America Retail Centre, purchased the property in 2018 and set out to complete this \$14 million major renovation project viewed by nearly 60,000 cars each day.

In addition to the exterior façade improvements and the east end building expansion, Midland Atlantic's renovation project included parking lot upgrades, adding LED lighting and new landscaping.

Midland Atlantic also announced Krispy Kreme will build a nearly 3,600 square-foot, stand-alone doughnut shop as part of the Tylersville Pointe redevelopment. Krispy Kreme will be built between First Financial Bank and Taco Bell facing Tylersville Road.

The east wing of the development includes long-time tenant Big Lots with a recently completed expansion to its existing store. Now with more than 40,000 square-feet the Big Lots promises a "Store of the Future" shopping experience. Big Lots offers furniture, food, décor and more.

The Twin Dragon Buffet & Grill next door to the Big Lots also received a full face lift and is now open with its endless spread of delicious Chinese mainstays.

Midland Atlantic constructed a new 22,000 square-foot space on the east side of the Tylersville Pointe development for Ross Dress for Less, a retailer new to the Township offering the latest designer and brand-name fashions for family and home at extraordinary savings.

The 14,000 square-foot west side of the development, also completely remodeled, will have three new tenants—Milk Bar Cafe, Lakomka Deli and Compunet Labs.

In addition, west side tenants renewing leases include Casablanca Mediterranean Food, Tobacco Marketplace and Dancing Roll. Dancing Roll expanded into a larger 2,250 square-foot space as part of the renovation.

Midland Atlantic continues to actively market the remaining 1,200-square-foot vacant storefront. In just more than two decades, the managing principals of Midland Atlantic have developed a strong foundation and assembled a team of talented professionals who work together to provide full-service retail real estate solutions in an ever changing climate.

Midland Atlantic is responsible for the majority of the retail development in West Chester's uptown district including The Voice of America Centre, Tylersville Farms and Tylersville Corner. With a population of more than 145,000 within a 30-mile radius of the Voice of America area, Midland Atlantic has the national retailer contacts and extensive market knowledge to help best position tenants and other property owners for success.



WEST CHESTER EXPERIENCES PERMIT GROWTH SPURT

The pandemic has not stopped West Chester Community Development staff from serving the business and residential communities of West Chester this year.



Business and residential permits continue to be

processed. In fact, the West Chester Board of Trustees waived all fees for residential permits beginning this spring and for the remainder of 2020 to help the community during times of uncertainty. This may have attributed to the greater number of permits requested/processed.

West Chester Community Development Department staff worked closely with several companies on major projects this year including the GE Additive project with a 171,000 square-foot expansion at the West Chester Trade Center. Fameccanica's 84,000 square-foot relocation and expansion of its North American corporate headquarters and Republic Wire's new 400,000 square-foot facility expansion at the Trade Center, to name a few, were also piloted through permitting processes by West Chester Community Development staff in recent months.

In conjunction with REDI Cincinnati, West Chester also assisted Sugar Creek Packaging with the expansion of its corporate headquarters, adding 120 new jobs in the township.

Through third quarter, West Chester Township staff have been involved in more than 1.5 million square feet of new commercial projects totaling more than \$64.5 million in new capital investment. These new projects brought with them 488 new jobs and retained 867 new jobs in West Chester Township.

The Community Development Department continues to process permit applications while restricting inperson contact and is now working to develop an online process for submitting permit applications for the benefit of its customers. A complete review and update of West Chester's Zoning Resolution is also under way.

"West Chester continues to engage our partners on developing new and exciting opportunities to align our zoning resolution and our plan submittal requirements to the needs of our private citizens and developers," said Aaron Wiegand, Director of West Chester Community Development." "As these two initiatives roll out in 2021, West Chester will continue to be a leader in responding to the needs of the community as we strive to be one of the "Best Places to Live" and "Best Communities to Conduct Business."

El Trompo Mexican Grill


